# Mental Health

## Students:

I would feel comfortable asking an adult for help if I felt worried, sad, or scared

3rd-5th = **74% favorable**

I would feel comfortable seeking help for my mental health at school

6th-8th = **64% favorable**

9th-12th = **58% favorable**



## Staff:

If I was concerned about my own mental health, I would have access to the support I need.

**88% favorable**



## Families:

My child knows how to get help at school if they are worried or need support.

**88% favorable**



# Sense of Belonging

## Students:

Overall, how much do you feel like you belong at your school?

3rd-5th = **85% favorable**

6th-8th = **84% favorable**

9th-12th = **83% favorable**



## Staff:

I personally feel a sense of belonging in our school community

**89% favorable**

Our school is effective at helping students feel like they belong

**93% favorable**



## Families:

My child feels a sense of belonging at their school

**90% favorable**



# Cell Phone Policy

## Students:

The new cell phone policy has improved the school environment.

6th-8th = **63% favorable**

9th-12th = **47% favorable**



## Staff:

The new student cell phone policy has improved the school environment.

**83% favorable**



## Families:

The restrictions against cell phones in classrooms have been helpful for the school environment.

**85% favorable**

**86% favorable**

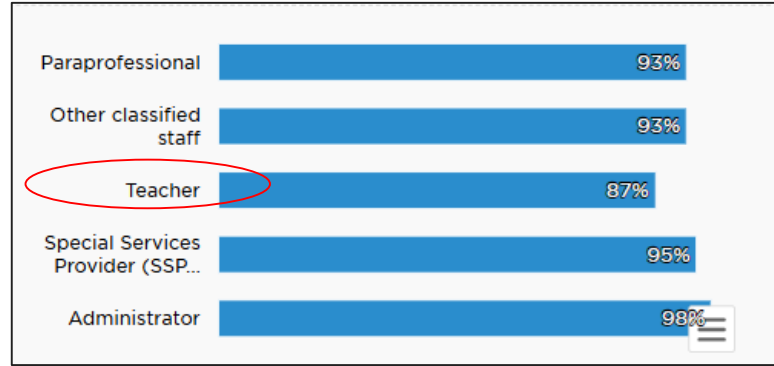
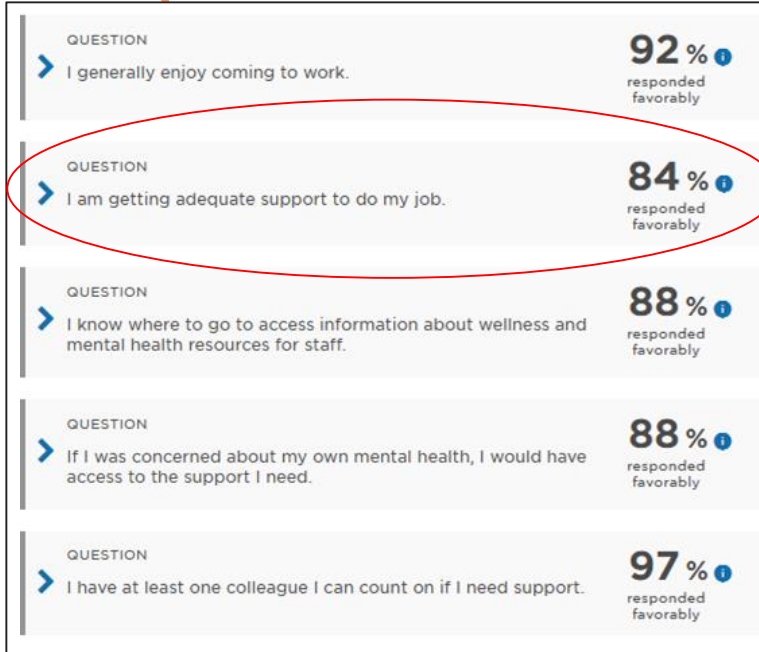


## Families:

**93% favorable**

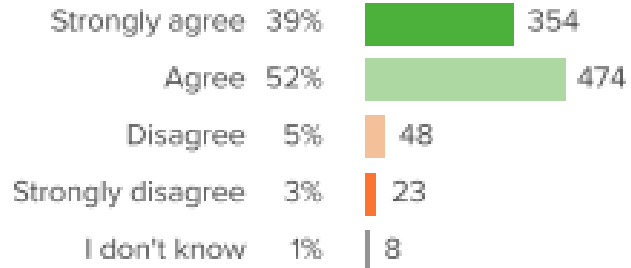

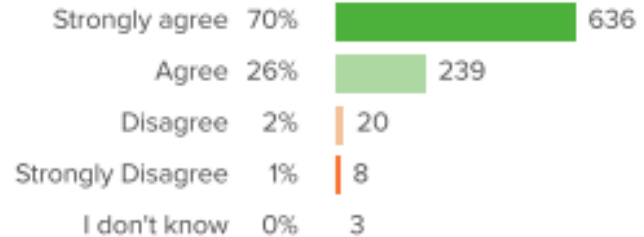
Q.1: I generally enjoy coming to work.
