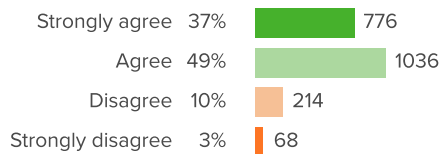

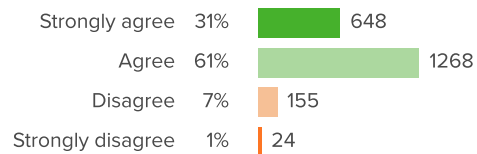

Q.1: I feel confident in making sure my child's school meets their learning needs.



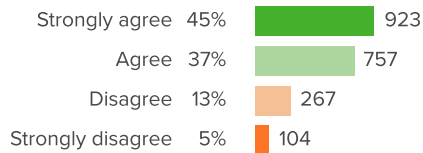

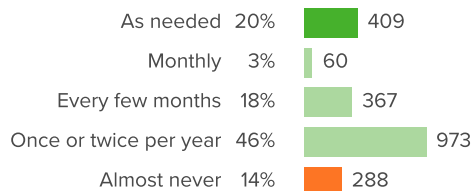

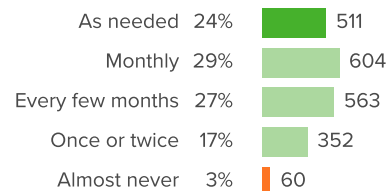

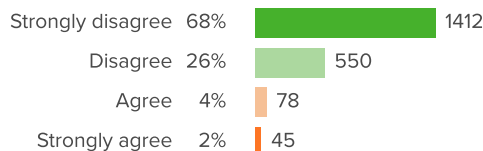
Q.2: In the past year, how often have you visited your child's school?

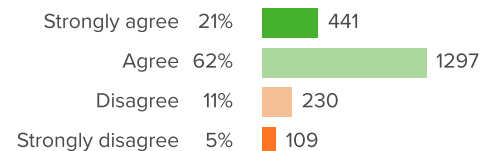

Q.3: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: Concerns about getting to the school safely?



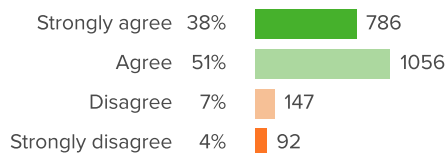

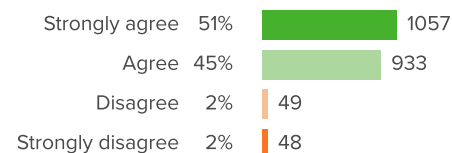

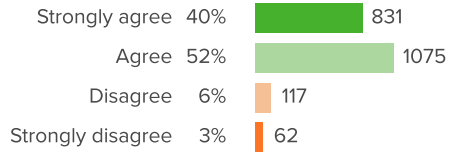

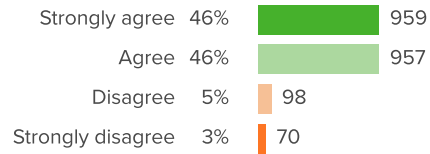

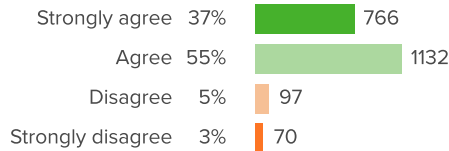

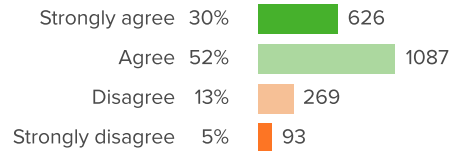

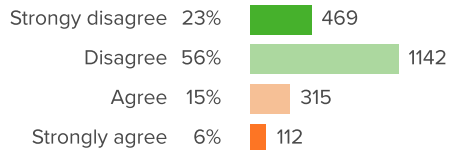

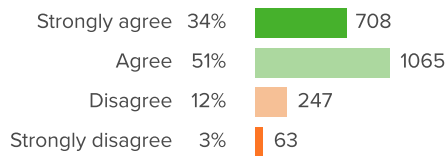

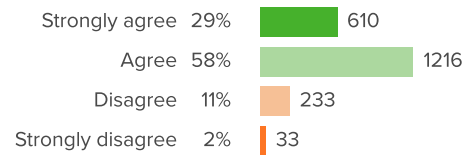

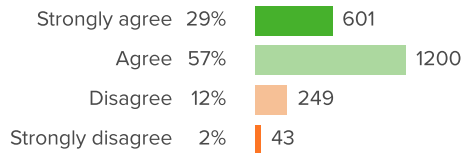

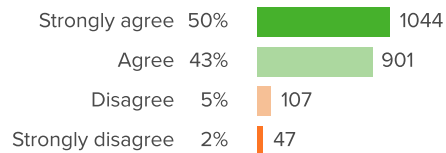

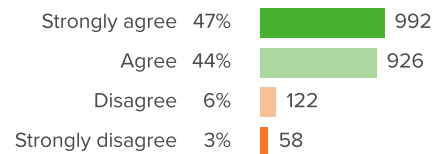

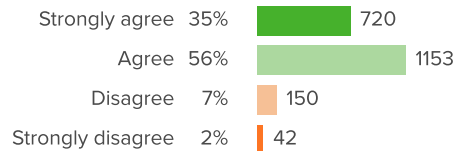

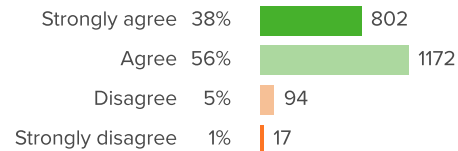

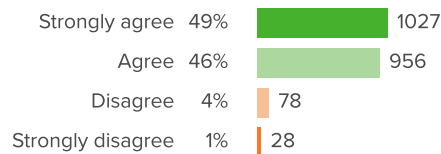

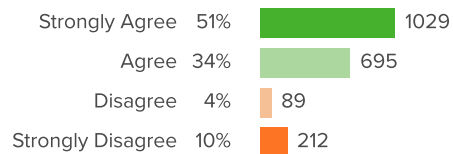

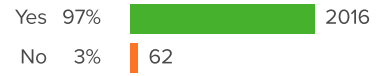

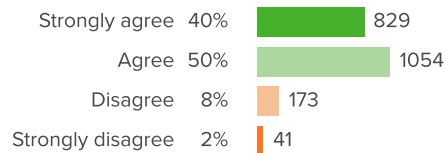

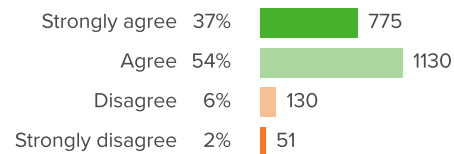

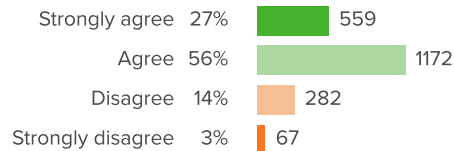

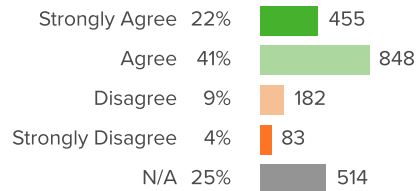

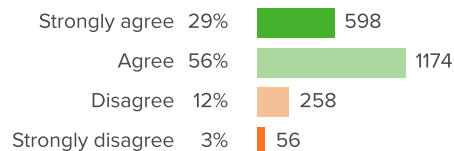

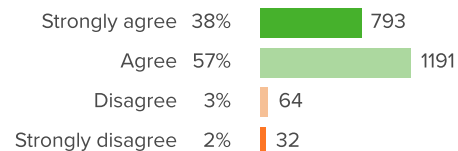

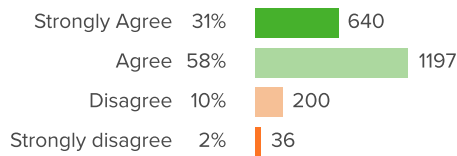

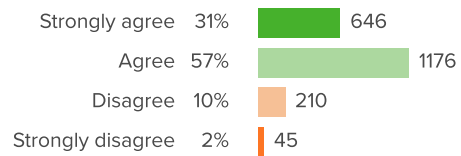

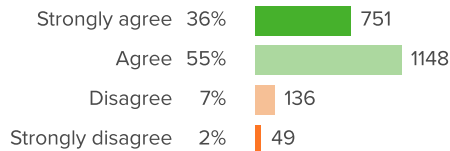

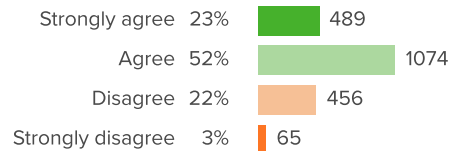

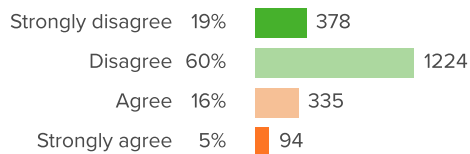

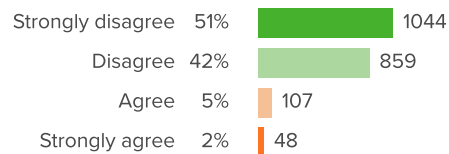

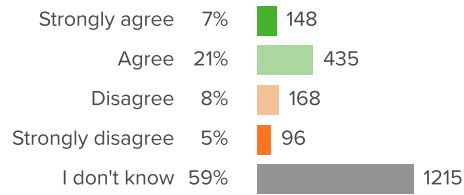

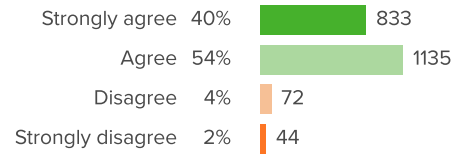

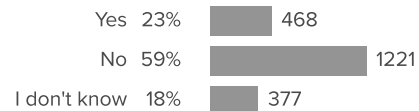

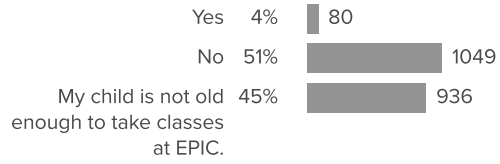

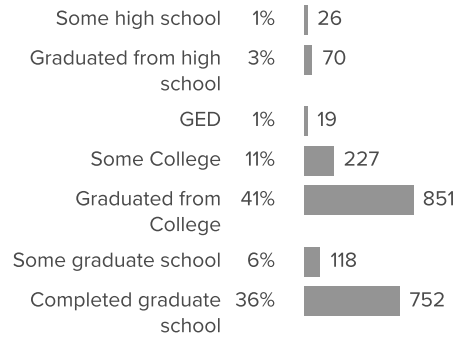
